Activities:

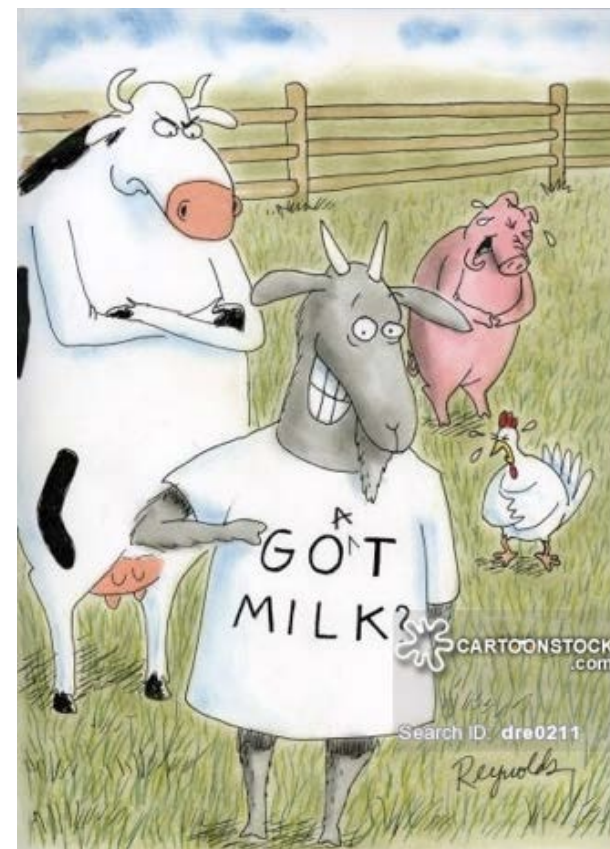
- Feed, clean and care for goats
